

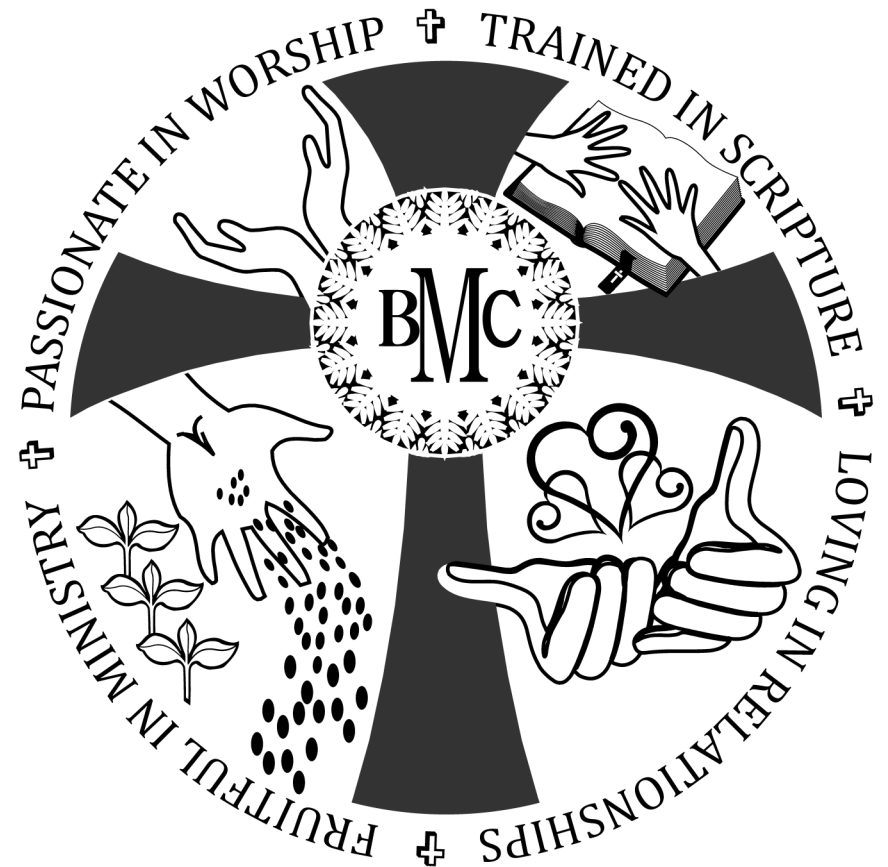
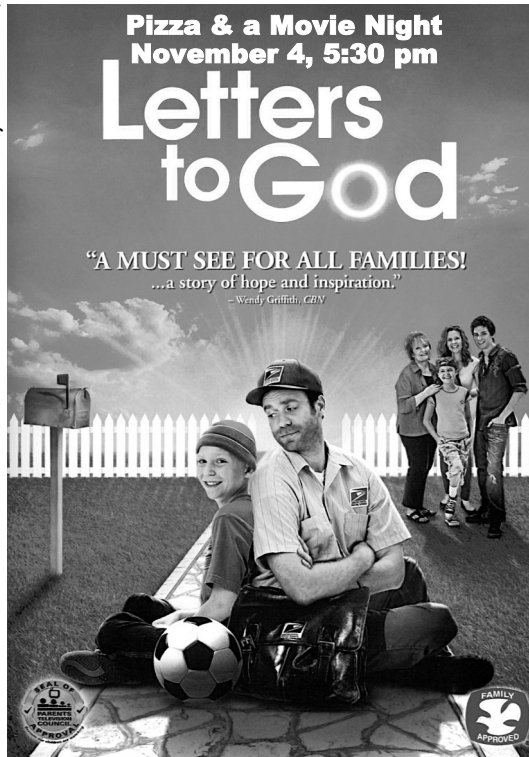
# Bethel Mennonite Church
