THE REUBEN SHORT SCHOLARSHIP



ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for consideration for a scholarship, an individual must:

- be a member of or a committed attendee of a local FEC church
- be enrolled full time (12 hours minimum/semester) in a Christian college or university that is a member of the Coalition of Christian Colleges and Universities (CCCU) or a Bible college that is accredited by the Association for Biblical Higher Education (ABHE)
- will be enrolled as a sophomore or higher for the 2019-2020 academic year
- submit a letter of confirmation of membership/ commitment from a pastor of their local FEC church

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Completed applications must be postmarked, emailed/faxed no later than Tuesday, Jan 15, 2019.

AWARDS

The Board of Directors of CSF shall make the final selections of individual recipients.

- Undergraduate awards made in January, 2019 for the 2019-2020 academic year can be up to \$750* for those who will be sophomores, juniors or seniors.
- Graduate students may receive a one-time award up to \$1,000* for a Master's Program and a one-time award up to \$1,000* for a Doctoral Program.
- Scholarship recipients will be notified via email address provided on application.
